UNIVERSITY CREDIT THROUGH BVAR/WBRCP PROGRAM

Participants of the Belize Valley Archaeological Reconnaissance Project and the Western Belize Regional Cave Project can get undergraduate credit through the University of Mississippi (Ole Miss).

In order to register for university credit, UM needs to receive the applications at least one month in advance of the beginning of the program.

Credit Hour Options and Fees (credit, insurance, and application fee)

3 credit hours USD\$ 690.00 1st or 2nd summer session

6 credit hours USD\$ 1340.00 1st and 2nd summer sessions

Note: Payment for credit hours must be paid to The University of Mississippi.

Students will be enrolled in Study Abroad Health Insurance while participating. This insurance, through Cultural Insurance Services International, <http://www.culturalinsurance.com/>, includes medical evacuation and repatriation benefits.

Applicants must complete the following:

- Complete the application for undergraduate admission to the University of Mississippi. https://secure.olemiss.edu/services/appl_index.html. You should print the "printable admissions application" and complete it as a non-degree seeking, visiting student, in the College of Liberal Arts. Ignore the application fee. This is covered in the fees listed above. **Remember: the application deadline is one month before your session begins.**
- At the Study Abroad web site, http://www.outreach.olemiss.edu/study_abroad/, at the bottom part of page, print the health release form and complete it.
- Provide a recent transcript or a letter of good academic standing from your current university registrar. This step will simply involve you calling the registrar of your current university and asking them to fax the Ole Miss Study Abroad office a letter telling them that you are a current student. The fax # is (662)-915-6798 (or +1-662-915-6798 for students calling from abroad).
- A personal check or cashier's check (in USD\$) for the number of credit hours for which you will be enrolled. Checks should be made out to The University of Mississippi.
- Mail to our office the undergraduate application for admission, the health release form, the letter of good standing or transcript (unless your registrar faxed this), and your check to the following address:
